DOWNLOADING THE INSTALLATION FILES

- 1. Log into your Edu-Portal Account
- 2. Click on CBT Client Menu
- 3. Click on **Download CBT Client**
- 4. Three files will be available for download
 - i. NDP452.exe
 - ii. VCx86.exe
 - iii. CBT Client.msi
- 5. Click on each file to start the download process

INSTALLING C.B.T. CLIENT

- 1. Install NDP452.exe and please note that you may be prompted to restart your computer
- 2. Install VCx86.exe
- 3. Finally, install CBT_Client.msi

LOGGING INTO THE CBT CLIENT SOFTWARE


- 1. After successfully installing the software, locate the **CBT Client Logo** on your desktop. It has the BIU logo as its logo

- 6. Further, you will have a list of all the registered and approved courses displayed to you




7. Double click on the examination that you want to take

- 2. Student should simply click on Start Exam




- 3. The Questions will be shown to the student

- 6. When you are through with the examination, simply click on the Submit Exam button on the top left corner of the screen




MULTIPLE CHOICE QUESTIONS
